Seth Mitchell Prayer Update



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Thank you for your prayers for Seth. People have asked how he is doing, so here is a brief report. Since the last Prayer Update, Seth has had several appointments with his cardiologist, pulmonologist, and a couple of others. His cardiologist was very pleased with how Seth is doing. The right side of his heart still has an elevated pressure, but it is much less than before surgery, and with balloon angioplasty in May, they hope to bring it down even further.

His lungs are still a point of concern. Jennifer and Brandon work together to provide Seth with his daily therapy. He has to be careful not to get any infection that would settle in his lungs, as it would almost certainly mean hospitalization. He was near that point earlier this year, but seeing how faithful Jennifer and Brandon are with his therapy, they allowed him to stay at home. Praise the Lord he got through it.



On Monday, 4 March, Seth had a complete checkup by his pediatrician. He was cleared for a visit to South Africa. His

As I write this email, they are on the first leg of their flight and will arrive tomorrow night, just after 10 PM South African time (4 PM EDT). Jennifer sent this picture once they boarded the plane in St. Louis. I asked if Seth was excited. She replied, "He is very, very excited!" I think Lucinda and I are as excited as he is! Jennifer wants to help us with our deaf Camp, which is planned for the last week of this month.

Please keep Seth in your prayers while he is here. They will be returning to the USA in mid-April.

Again, we thank you all for your prayers for him during this journey. What God has done in Seth's seven years is truly amazing.
