We held our International Quiz this past weekend and it was an exciting time to see people from five languages (English, Polish, Ukrainian, Hungarian, and Lithuanian) compete to see who knew the book of Ephesians best. But the most encouraging part of this happened after the Quizzing was over and we asked people to share testimonies about the impact that studying for the Quiz had on their life.

One day Bartek was reciting the verses to himself as he went into a store. The lady at the store asked him what he was doing and so he told her that he was studying for the Quiz!
