FLYING IN THE CLOUDS

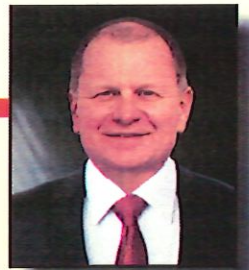
A friend was sharing with me that his father was an Air Force pilot for thirty-plus years. He flew everything from open-cockpit biplanes to jet fighters.

As he was explaining to me when you could not see at night, or through clouds, you didn't have to guess because there was a special gauge for that. I realized that it also had a very strong spiritual application.

When a pilot is flying at night, in the clouds, or even in a storm he needs to keep his eyes on his instruments, in particular the attitude indicator (artificial horizon). This gauge in the cockpit was to help him understand what he could not see in front of him. By watching this gauge it would tell him if he were aiming the plane up, down, or turning.

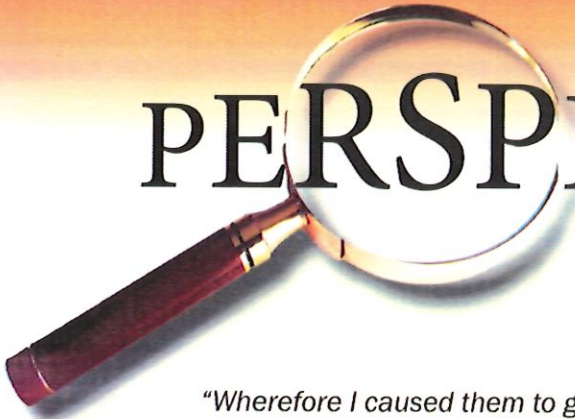

1	Completed construction of the boy's dormitory first-floor ceiling. Work has now begun to construct windows and parging of the walls.	Bethany House Orphanage, Saclepea, Liberia
2	Continued construction of the footers for the Patricia Carey High School in Mowoto Village.	Mowoto, SL.
3	Continued construction of a church and well in Mogbetu Village	Mogbetu, SL.
4	Continued construction of the walls for the Gloria Arnold High School	Moriba Town, SL.
5	Work is now focused on planting and harvesting vegetables in five (5) acres of tillable land at the Mattru Orphanage farm. Pastor Brooks expects to start tilling and planting palm oil tree saplings on the remaining 15 acres of the farmland in December of this year.	Near Mattru Jung, SL.
6	Pastor Brooks has started a new school and two home cell churches near the village of Njagbema, Sierra Leone. The school is supporting 50 students.	Moyamba Junction, SL.
7	Hosted Pastor George Dapaah from Ghana University to teach several courses at Makripodis College.	Moyamba Junction, SL.
8	WEO sent an additional 40' ocean transport container to Sierra Leone with various materials and desks in preparation (mostly) for the construction team that will be visiting on November 5 th , 2024.	The team traveling to SL in November is from western PA.
9	Solomon traveled to Ghana in September to meet with Pastor Sebastian Baku and his family and also to attend the University in Ghana to take some graduate-level courses toward his master's degree.	Ho, Volta Ghana Accra, Ghana
10	The JE Sykes scholarship program has invested in a van that provides a taxi service in Freetown for the purpose of providing scholarship funds to students attending Makripodis College. WEO Director Rescue-A-Child Ministry

Happy Fall Ya'll! And greetings to you in the name of Jesus. As I sit here praying about what good news from Africa to start with in this article, I marvel once again, as I do every year, at the creative fall colors God so masterfully displays through the ingenious process that He uses for the trees to let go of their leaves. Eccl. 3:1 "To everything there is a season, and a time to every purpose under heaven." How comforting it is to know that we serve a Holy, All-Powerful God that LOVES us and has our best interest in mind. Even through the trials, He has us! Though our circumstances may be dark and uncertain, and our "letting go" may not look as colorful as the autumn trees, God's creation shows us once again that He IS in control and that as we let go, trusting Him, new growth will occur.

Now for news from Africa: The boys' dorm at the Bethany House orphanage in Liberia, is gaining ground toward completion. The walls inside and out are currently getting parged, and soon the cement flooring will be poured and tiling laid. The windows have been installed and doors are being built.

Currently, there are 265 students enrolled in the K-12 school which is on the orphanage compound. We need school desks!! A total of 300 desks are needed and the cost is \$50 each. This price covers transportation. These desks are American-made and will last for many years. There will be updated information on the website as to our progress for this project. Please put "RCM school desk" in the memo of any PayPal or check written for this endeavor.

We are excited to see the House of Grace orphanage in Sierra Leone has started school this year with an attendance of 139 students! Excited to see this new school grow as last year was it's first full year. What a blessing to be able to open these schools up not only for the benefit of our children at each orphanage but also to the children that live in nearby towns and villages. This gives these children the opportunity to also hear the gospel and have Bible class five days a week! That is so exciting to me. Our goal in starting all these schools there is to capture the hearts of the children while they are young. These children in turn can take the Good News home to their parents and our prayer is that the parents will start coming to church and of course, accept Christ.

God has graciously provided for me to leave on October 28 to visit each orphanage and update the RCM profiles. It is my goal for each sponsor to receive an updated picture and a letter from your child upon my return to the States. Please pray for strength, safety, and spiritual productivity as I will also hold VBS in several bush villages and at each orphanage school. Some of these children and adults will be hearing the gospel for the first time.

1. Money for 300 school desks (\$50 each)
2. Sponsors for the unsponsored children. (our orphanage budget is often in the red)
3. Safety as I travel October 28-November 17
4. Souls to be saved and all to be encouraged as I minister in several WEO churches.
