GLENS FALLS REVERB

November 8-9th marked the 7th time we have hosted Reverb in Glens Falls, NY. This year we broke the record for highest attendance ever: **1,516!** During our event, Pastor Chris Goeppner shared the truth of the Gospel and 143 students responded to the invitation. Of those who responded, 95 made professions of faith, 26 made a dedication decision, and 22 of them came back to talk to a counselor but made no decision.

Please pray for those 22 who showed interest in the Gospel, but have yet to believe in Jesus for salvation. Pray also for the follow up that will happen with those who trusted Christ.

As you can imagine, with an attendance of over 1,500, we needed a big staff to help us with this event. Thank you to the 120 people who helped make Reverb happen. A special thank you to the Word of Life Bible Institute students and the students from Northeastern Baptist College who served all night at the Dome, the bowling alleys and at Sky Zone. Thank you to Rico Lopez and Tatianne O'Bradovic for running the Dome and the Dome Leader's Room!

Each year at Reverb we offer a "Student Reaching Student" tickets—these are half-price ticket for students who are unsaved. These tickets are funded by people who love Reverb and want to see students come to Jesus. This year, we sold all of the half-price tickets that we had funded.
