

PRAISE

1. We had a tremendous trip to Oaxaca in Nov., meeting newly saved people in Paxtlán and seeing the ones we were discipling before

schedule. We have 2 more months of furlough before we head back to Oaxaca, hopefully by the end of January or first of February. We have enjoyed seeing many of you that we haven't seen since deputation 10 plus years ago. God has been good to us and has blessed us during these months home in the U.S.

The first week of November Amy and I made a 10 day trip back to Oaxaca. We had 2 main objectives while we were there.

#1 We received our 29th trailer of Scripture on November 8th. **This trailer put us over the 52 million mark of Scripture distributed through Mission of Grace Oaxaca.** We have 2 more trailers scheduled for early 2026. Please be in prayer for these.

#2 To start the process of giving a whole Bible to each student in the school district of San Andrés Paxtlán. We were given permission back in June, and a supporting church here in the U.S. purchased the Bibles for these schools. We were honored to have this church join us this week and help us pass out the Bibles to the students. **We were able to get in to 8 of the 29 schools. We handed out close to 600 whole Bibles that week.** The students and teachers were delighted to receive a Bible of their own. One teacher told her students, "this is the greatest gift that you will ever receive." Another teacher kissed his Bible upon receiving it. We are thankful that God has opened the doors for us to be able to work in Paxtlán. We covet your prayers for this church plant. Our eyes were open as to how many families that live in this community - how many people still haven't heard about Jesus Christ. The president (like a mayor) and government positions will be changing in January. We pray that the new people voted in will also give us the freedom to evangelize as we have been able to since January. Pray for the hearts of the families of the school kids that took their Bibles home that day! Pray for Pastor Julio and Esmeralda as they follow up and continue to witness and spiritually encourage the people in Paxtlán. Thank you to Pastor VanAman and his church family that sacrificed to purchase Bibles for this community! Only God knows the impact this gesture will make for eternity. We Praise the Lord for what He did this week with the Bible distribution and the trailer arrival!

We make an assembly line to unload each pallet into an organized section for each type of literature. After all of the pallets are unloaded, Joe then gives out boxes from each section to the pastors and ministries that have come from near and far. We also take several truck loads back to the Bible warehouse located at the mission base where the Scripture is then mailed out or pastors come and pick up what they need. We praise God for this ministry and all that He has done so that people of Oaxaca, other states in Mexico and beyond can receive a portion of God's Word.
