

In addition to working in Ohio throughout the last few months, we have been able to make a very important trip to the middle east. In November we traveled with the Zarris' family to Turkey and Iraq. We were able to have some important meetings with the radio station staff of the Baghdad and Kurdistan ministries. Now 6 stations are on the air preaching the Gospel to the people of that region. While there with Brother Edgar Feghaly, we had the joy of meeting a man that had trusted Christ because of the radio station. Prior to his salvation, he was a muslim Imam who directed a muslim congregation. His entire life he had



preached hatred toward people and nationalities. His teaching idealized rejoicing at the death and suffering of Americans, Japanese, and Jews. However, that all changed when he "accidentally" turned on his car radio to our station there, New Testament Baptist Radio. He was immediately confronted with Scripture when he listened, and the Holy Spirit began to move in his heart. He later tuned in again and God continued to draw him to salvation. He eventually received Christ, and his life was completely transformed. He is now no longer the leader of a mosque, he is a member of the Baptist church in Bagdad. He no longer carries hatred in his heart, but rather the Love of Jesus Christ. Stories like this are being written each day around the world because of Christian media and the power of preaching the Word of God.



As we returned from the Middle East, we took a detour to Romania, where there is a possible ministry opportunity. We are burdened to begin a studio that can record Gospel content for use in that region. This project is in conjunction with Christian Media International. Your prayers for wisdom and provision are greatly appreciated. There is a great need and currently there is an open door.

Looking forward to the first quarter of 2026, we need to make two large international ministry trips. Philippines and Liberia are both ready for the installation of several new Christian radio stations. Tickets will be expensive and the equipment will need to be purchased soon. Please continue to lift up these projects in your prayers. We are looking forward to getting these installations finished up and to helping hundreds of thousands of souls hear the truth! John 3:16 is for everyone and radio, audio, and video are great tools for the church to use to make Jesus known!
