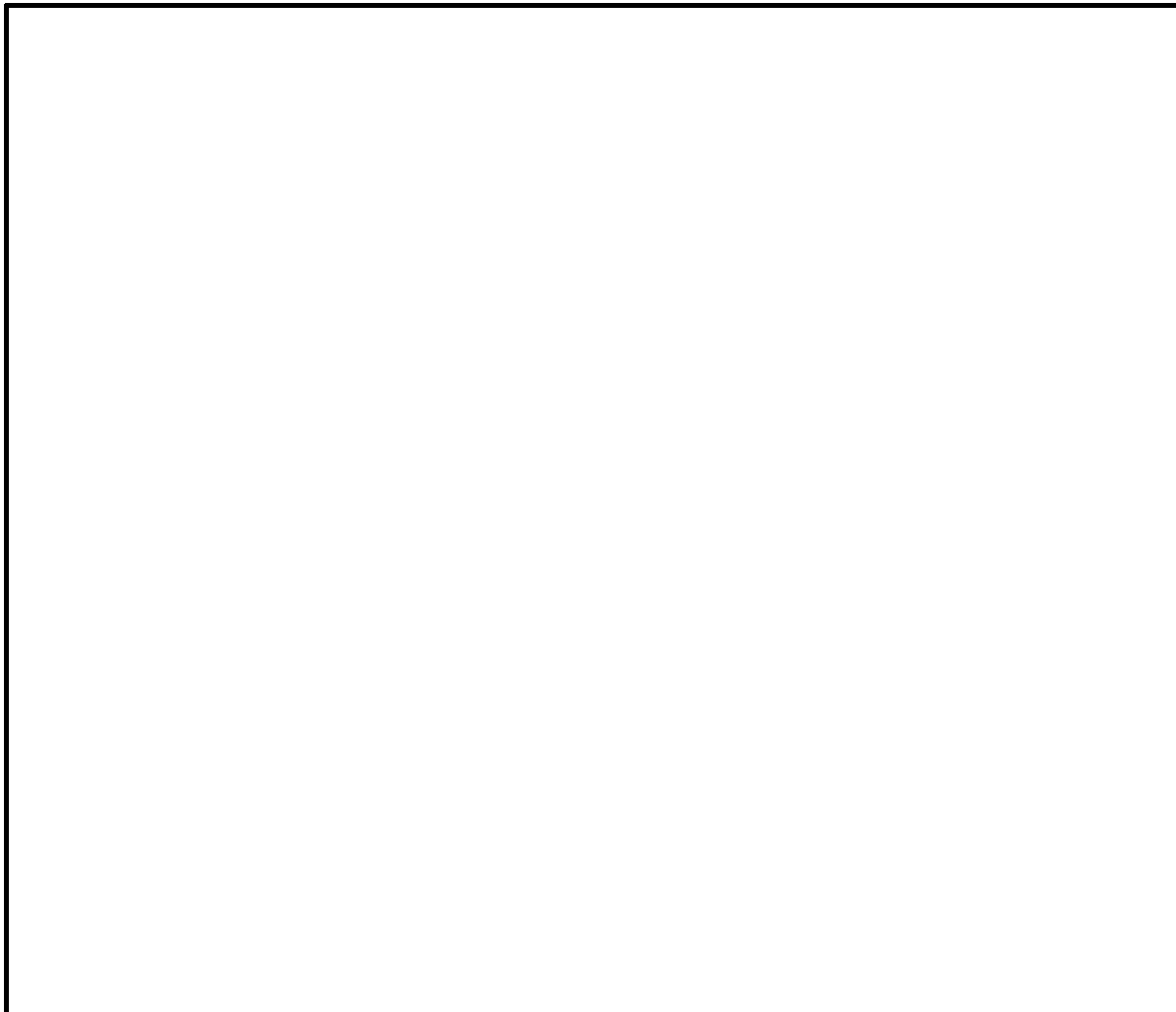

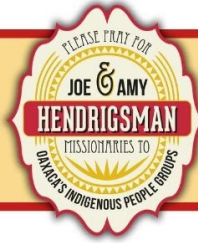
## Oaxaca Ministry Update

Dear Faithful Church and Praying Friends, Jan. - Feb. 2026  
 We arrived back to Oaxaca on February 4<sup>th</sup> and are so thankful to be back home where God called us to serve Him! We had a wonderful 6 month furlough, visiting supporting churches and a handful of new churches. We are grateful for the added support God allowed us to raise to replace a few lost supporters during our first term. God always supplies our needs and continues to bless us and the ministry here in Oaxaca. We are now into our 10<sup>th</sup> year of serving Him in Oaxaca!

We hit the ground running upon our return home. We just finished hosting a medical team where we ministered in the mountain region of San Andrés Paxtlán. Lighthouse Baptist Church from Michigan, joined BOHMM to minister physically while Pastor Melchidas and his team ministered spiritually by sharing the gospel with each patient. We saw 320 patients in 3 different towns over 4 days. We had 167 individuals come to Christ. Each of these towns are a part of San Andrés Paxtlán, where we are planting Guiding Light Baptist Church. We held a service on Saturday evening after our last day of clinic. We were enlightened to see 3 families who have remained faithful since last January when Amy and I started the Bible Study under sister Juana's awning. There were also 2 new families in attendance that Pastor Julio and Ms. Esmeralda have been ministering to and a brand new family and single lady that had never come before. Pastor Scott preached and Pastor Julio translated a message from Ephesians 1. Please be in prayer as we continue ministering in the mountains while Pastor Julio and Ms. Esmeraldo go back home to Chihuahua for a few months to have their baby.

Right now we are constructing a new Bible Warehouse that will double our capacity and help us be better organized to distribute God's Word. Please pray for the \$9,000.00 USD needed to finish this building. We have several trailers lined up for this year and have contacted several attorneys to help us with the necessary importation paperwork. There are new laws that came into affect January 1<sup>st</sup>, and because of this, there is a hold up in getting our first trailer of the year on its way. Please pray for the paperwork process and details of the new construction.

Over the last month we have also mailed Scripture to Sinaloa, Guerrero, Tamaulipas, Guanajuato, Tabasco, Quintana Roo, Sonora and within our state of Oaxaca. We thank the Lord for people that continue asking for the Word of God!
