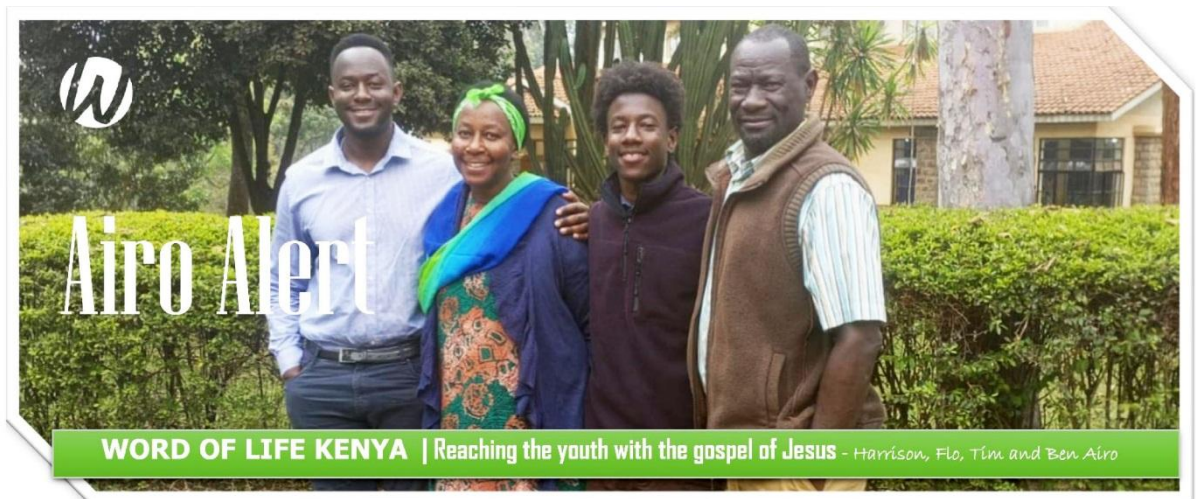




Psalm 113: 3
